#### **JOB SUMMARY:**

This position serves as a co-teacher for a classroom with a direct focus on children ages 6 weeks -3 years of age.

The co-teacher will work collaboratively with another Teacher(s) to ensure the successful operation of a classroom with a total of 8 children mixed in age from 6 weeks of age to 3 years of age. The co-teacher also works with a team of other classroom teachers and family members to implement the Creative Curriculum to achieve outcomes for children of all abilities. The Early Head Start (EHS) co-teacher is **responsible for communicating effectively with infants, toddlers, their parents and other staff**. The EHS co- teacher properly addresses the developmental needs of infants and toddlers. Demonstrate knowledge of the Head Start Performance Standards policies and procedures.
