JOB SUMMARY:

The Nutrition Aide is responsible for the operation of the kitchen.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Receives and stores food and supplies for the food service program of the Head Start Center.
- Serves meals (breakfast, lunch, and snack) according to guidelines.
- Must be able to understand portions and sizes.
- Maintains safe and sanitary conditions in the food service area.
- Maintains appropriate records and submits as required.
- Recruits volunteers and in-kind contributions.
- Performs other duties as assigned by the Site Supervisor or Child Development Director.
- Responsible for knowledge of the Head Start Program Performance Standards.
- This position requires heavy lifting of cartons/trays/pans of food.
- Prepares food for children with special dietary needs.
- Prepares food for special occasions such as Policy Council meetings, etc
- Must have the ability to maintain inventory and supplies and to order groceries by the menu.
- Must be able to submit reports accurately and timely.
- Ability to work with children and adults of a multi-cultured society and of diverse ethnic origins.
- Previous experience in quantity cooking.
- Ability to follow written and verbal instructions, including recipes.
- Ability to order, receive, and store supplies.
- * Knowledge of proper temperature for food, freezer, and refrigerator.
- * Knowledge of the use of all electrical appliances.
- Support school readiness by providing visually appealing, tasteful, and appropriate meals that meet the nutritional needs of all program participant.
- Requires a High School Diploma or GED.
- All other duties as assigned by Management.

QUALIFICAIONS:

- Requires ServSafe certification required. Certification to be obtained within six (6) months of employment once a job offer is made.
- Responsible for assuring Head Start Performance Standards, DHR Minimum Standards and/or all pertinent program guidelines are adhered to at all times.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

Patient, able to resolve conflicts, gentle, kind, creative, and resourceful. Demonstrate ability to work effectively with people. Possess excellent problem solving, planning, and organizational skills. Detail and multi-task oriented with a strong desire to succeed. Must be able to cope well with stress.

While performing this job, the employee is frequently to sit; stand; stoop; bend; walk; talk; hear; use hands to grip; type; reach with hands and arms, occasionally required to stand or walk on uneven surfaces; climb stairs; run short distances. 2 to 4 hours per day spent in strenuous physical activity, lifting 30 pounds or more six or eight times in an 8-hour day.
