Head Start is a **free** comprehensive child development program for eligible families, and their children, which includes education, health, nutrition, family services, behavioral support, and family engagement.

Now serving children ages 3-5 years old in Monroe County.

Required documentation for enrollment:

- * Proof of age (Birth certificate)
- * Current Immunization Certificate
- * Parent photo I.D.
- * Proof of Income for previous 12 months (Pay stubs, W-2, 1040, Child support)
- * Proof of Public Assistance (TANF or SSI letter, etc.)
- * Proof of Foster Care (DHR placement form, court documents, etc.)
- * Proof of family experiencing Homelessness or temporary living situation (written statement from homeless service provider, school personnel, etc.)
- * If applicable– IEP documentation, legal guardianship documentation

Additional Documentation that may be required:

- * Social Security Cards
- * Proof of residency
- * Child's Health Insurance card (if available)
